

FOOTWEAR

Shoes must be enclosed for safety reasons (e.g. sneakers or leather school shoes). Velcro is encouraged for younger students. Shoes must be predominately black or white with matching laces. Coloured laces are not permitted. Socks must be white or black and cover the ankle.

SWIMWEAR

Students must wear sun safe swim shirts during all water-based activities, with the exception of competitions and carnivals. This is stipulated by the [Department of Education's Sun Safety Strategy](#). Swimming caps are also required for safety reasons. Swimming goggles are optional but not required.

JEWELLERY

The wearing of jewellery is discouraged at Craigslea State School. Acceptable jewellery include: watches (excluding smart-watches); one set of sleepers or studs worn in the ear only; and medical alert bracelets. Any jewellery worn by students is their responsibility. The school will not be held responsible for any loss or damage.

SUN-SAFETY AND UNIFORMS

The Craigslea school uniform must be worn at all times with the exception of free dress days. For safety reasons, the length of all dresses, shorts, skirts and skorts are to sit no shorter than the mid-point between the thigh and the knee and no longer than the knee. Additionally, all shirts must cover shoulders. During winter, plain navy tracksuit pants may be worn in place of shorts, skorts or skirts. Navy tights/stockings are permitted to be worn underneath dresses, skirts and skorts. Leggings (footless) are not permitted.

SCHOOL SPORTS HOUSE SHIRTS

The School Sports House shirts can be worn at school only (not on excursions) on Wednesdays and on sports days such as athletics and swimming carnivals etc.

HATS

A school broad brimmed or bucket hat must be worn for all outdoor activities including, and not limited to, lunch time play and any outdoor class-based lessons.

Students without a hat are required to sit down in designated shaded areas during play time. Craigslea State School has a 'no hat, no play' expectation.

HAIR / MAKE-UP / NAIL POLISH

Students' hair is to be neatly presented, not impair vision and tied back if longer than shoulder length. Hair should be of natural colour and style with cuts not less than a blade 2 at all times. Hair accessories should be minimal and in school colours. Large hair bows or bright coloured accessories are not permitted. Nail polish and make-up is not permitted.

STUDENT SCHOOL LEADERS

Representation in student leadership positions (i.e. Student Councillor, Sporting and Leadership Positions and Teams) is dependent on adherence to our school dress code.

Applications for an alteration or variation to the school uniform can be made to the Craigslea State School Uniform Exception Panel via the school principal (e.g. religious, cultural, medical reasons). Decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis and will require evidence of reason for request.

Parents will be contacted for any non compliance with uniform policy.
