\$270,333

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of Prep 2 students able to read and comprehend short predictable texts and compose and record short, meaningful sentences from 85% at the reporting level of Working With or better to 88%. This will be achieved by reducing the number of students leaving Prep with a PM Reading level below 7 from 13% in 2021 to 10% in 2022.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 to 6 children achieving English A to C from 90% to 93%
- Improve the number of students in Prep to 2 achieving A/B from 49% to 52%
- Improve the number of students in Years 3 to 6 achieving A/B from 50% to 53%
- Employ teacher-aides to support the implementation of effective literacy programs targeted to the needs of students.
- Resource targeted learning teams (consisting of classroom teachers, targeted learning teachers
 and teacher-aides) on each year level who will engage in focussed collaborations based on
 student data to improve teaching and learning for all students within a full inclusion model.
